JAT Pharmacy, LLC, (JAT) dispenses prescription and non-prescription veterinary medications/products that are prescribed and approved by a licensed veterinarian who has established a veterinarian/client/patient relationship (VCPR) per Boards of Veterinary and Pharmacy rules. VCPRs ensure the integrity, legitimacy, and authenticity of prescription drug orders.

VCPR means a relationship between a veterinarian, a client, and the patient in which all of the following apply:

- The veterinarian has assumed the responsibility for making medical judgments regarding the health of the patient and the patient's need for medical treatment, and the client has agreed to accept those medical judgments and to follow the related instructions of the veterinarian.
- The veterinarian has sufficient knowledge of the patient to initiate a general or preliminary diagnosis of the medical condition of the patient because the veterinarian has recently examined the patient or has made medically appropriate and timely visits to the premises on which the patient is kept.
- The veterinarian is readily available for follow-up treatment of the patient if the patient has an adverse reaction to veterinary treatment.

The veterinarian and customer are free to choose any pharmacy (online or physical) to fulfill their prescription needs. At no time is a veterinarian's or customer's choice of pharmacy limited to solely JAT. Also, customers may transfer their prescriptions from JAT to any other pharmacy of their choice. Pharmacy right of choice and ability to transfer prescriptions are mandated by state Boards of Pharmacy.

In accordance with state Boards of Pharmacy rules, a prescription drug order must be issued by a licensed prescriber.

JAT requires a veterinarian to register his/her state veterinary license number with their MyVetStoreOnline account. The veterinarian's state license number is associated with each prescription created for each item prescribed by the veterinarian and subsequently dispensed by JAT.

Upon a review of a submitted prescription if the veterinarian's license is expired, JAT Pharmacy will cancel/purge the prescription order and future orders associated with that license in compliance with state Boards of Pharmacy rules along with JAT's Policy & Procedure Manual.

No further prescriptions will be accepted, nor future orders fulfilled for that veterinarian until his/her state license status has been returned to active.

JAT cannot take returns once prescription medication has been delivered to a customer's home, farm, ranch, etc., due to state Boards of Pharmacy requirements.
